The Multnomah County Sheriff's Office patrols more than 280 square miles of urban and rural area and is responsible for approximately 110 miles of waterways. Our highly trained and dedicated members work around the clock to provide exceptional public safety services for the communities of unincorporated Multnomah County and our contract cities of Fairview, Maywood Park, Troutdale, and Wood Village.

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Our Work

At MCSO, we are committed to providing closure for members of our community who have been impacted by crime. Numerous cases are investigated by our Detective Unit which includes general assignment detectives and those who have specialized experience in areas such as domestic violence and elder crimes. Our Civil Unit is responsible for serving and enforcing [court orders](#) and a variety of other documents issued by the courts, including protection orders or small claims.
